
Delivered Transactions in GSPL Network

Dear Members,

In pursuance of Byelaws and Market Rules of IGX, Members are hereby informed that under Clause 10.1.3 of Market Rules following is mentioned –

“a. Delivered Transaction: The Exchange shall facilitate the trade, physical delivery of Gas by booking the necessary transmission facility on behalf of the Buyer, and financial settlement for the traded Contracts. The Buyer shall be required to submit necessary documents for execution of GTA as prescribed by the Exchange from time to time to facilitate such transactions; and...”

Accordingly, the Members are hereby informed that buyers connected to the natural gas pipeline network of Gujarat State Petronet Limited (GSPL) can initiate Delivered Transactions at the Gas Exchange. In order to facilitate the transportation of gas for buyers at GSPL network, IGX has executed the Gas Transmission Agreement (GTA) with the Transporter.

Any buyer connected to GSPL network and desirous for Delivered transaction has to submit the Gas Transportation Undertaking (“GTU”) duly signed by the authorized person as per the format attached under Annexure-I with this Circular. Vide GTU, the buyer will undertake responsibility for all obligations and liabilities arising as a result of IGX signing the GTA.
